Lochaline WTW (TTU)

This works involved the design, construction, installation and commissioning of a new 195m3/d Nano-filtration Transportable Treatment Unit (TTU) membrane plant to replace the existing system on site including CWT & Aline Park Pumps.

An innovative design approach was required due to site topography and access constraints, this allowed for the incorporation of a modularised welfare unit to accommodate all of Scottish Water's operational requirements, and has been well received by our clients.

Utilising our group manufacturing capability ensured a collaborative approach for our clients. As principle contractor RSE also manufactured and produced the TTU, engaging PSI to manufacture a modular solution for the Sodium Hypochlorite dosing.

PSI adopted a pioneering approach which led to them bringing the main process line within the dosing unit, negating the need for extensive pipework runs and reduced the installation and maintenance requirements.

The TTU was designed, assembled and commissioned at Ross-shire Engineering's Muir of Ord facility. It was then divided into modules and carefully prepared for the 118 mile journey by road and ferry to the site location at Lochaline.
