The Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017

Re: Stainless Steel Process Pipework Systems

Thank you for your recent application to the Drinking Water Inspectorate (England and Wales) for re-approval of products or substances for use in the public water supply. This was in respect of **Stainless Steel Process Pipework Systems**.

The Drinking Water Inspectorate (England and Wales) undertakes this assessment on behalf of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland and your application is deemed to extend to Northern Ireland. As Northern Ireland has separate legislation from that applicable in England, Wales and Scotland, the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (the Department) has treated your application under Regulation 33 of the legislation above.

Following the re-approval of **Stainless Steel Process Pipework Systems** the Department hereby approves the introduction of this product in Northern Ireland on the same terms and conditions as set out in the approval notified to you by the Drinking Water Inspectorate (England and Wales) in its letter of **20**th **April 2021**.
